The Baptism of Matthew Hassan takes the place of the 3rd Antiphon and the Little Entrance. The Liturgy resumes with the Anti-Trisagion (“As many of you as have been baptized...”).

The Epistle Reading: 2 Corinthians 9:6-11

The Gospel Reading: Luke 10:25-37

p 45, instead of the Cherubic Hymn, sing p 295

p 77, The Lord’s Prayer – English first, Greek last

Communion: Orthodox Christians who have prepared themselves should come forward to receive the Eucharist. Others are invited to join us in partaking reverently of the blessed bread distributed at the close of the service, called *Antidoron* (*in place of the Gifts*).
