After the Great Blessing: Christ is risen from the dead... (first time clergy, then twice by all)

p 37, the 3rd Antiphon: Paschal Apolytikion

p 37, the Entrance Hymn: Bless God in the churches, the Lord from the fountains of Israel. Save us, O Son of God ...

Hymns after the Gospel Entrance

Thomas Sunday Apolytikion, p 155

Paschal Kontakion, p 275

The Epistle Reading: Acts 5:12-20

The Gospel Reading: John 20:19-31

p 45, instead of the Cherubic Hymn, sing p 295

p 69, instead of It is truly right, the Thomas Sunday Megalynarion, p 309

p 77, The Lord's Prayer – English first, Greek last

p 83, instead of normal Communion Hymn, sing p 320.

Communion: Orthodox Christians who have prepared themselves should come forward to receive the Eucharist. Others are invited to join us in partaking reverently of the blessed bread distributed at the close of the service, called *Antidoron* (in place of the Gifts).

After the Eucharist, Prayer of Thanksgiving, p 361

p 87, instead of "We have seen", Paschal Troparion

p 95, after the Amen:

Priest: Christ is risen! (3 times)

People: Truly He is risen! (3 times)

Priest: Glory to His Resurrection on the third day!

People: We worship His Resurrection on the third day!

Priest (spoken): Christ is risen from the dead...

People: Truly the Lord is risen!
