

p 83, instead of normal Communion Hymn, sing p 318

*Communion:* Orthodox Christians who have prepared themselves should come forward to receive the Eucharist.

After the Eucharist, Prayer of Thanksgiving, p 361

p 87, instead of "We have seen," sing Paschal Apolytikion

p 95, after the Amen:

Priest: Christ is risen! (3 x) People: Truly He is risen! (3 x)

Priest: Glory to His Resurrection on the third day!

People: We worship His Resurrection on the third day!

Priest (spoken): Christ is risen from the dead...

People: Truly the Lord is risen!
