

Paschal Antiphon Verses

*p 37, the 3rd Antiphon:* The Paschal Apolytikion*p 37, the Entrance Hymn:* Blessed God in the churches, the Lord from the fountains of Israel... Save us, O Son

Hymns after the Gospel Entrance Resurrection Apolytikion 3, p 107 Parish Apolytikion (inside hymnal cover) Paschal Kontakion, p 275

*The Epistle Reading:* Acts 9:32-42 *The Gospel Reading:* John 5:1-15

p 45, instead of the Cherubic Hymn, sing p 295

p 69, instead of It is truly right, sing p 305

p 77, The Lord's Prayer – English first, Greek last

p 83, instead of normal Communion Hymn, sing p 318

After the Eucharist, Prayer of Thanksgiving, p 361

p 87, instead of "We have seen," sing Paschal Apolytikion

p 95, after the Amen:

Priest: Christ is risen! (3 x) People: Truly He is risen! (3 x) Priest: Glory to His Resurrection on the third day! People: We worship His Resurrection on the third day! Priest (spoken): Christ is risen from the dead... People: Truly the Lord is risen!
