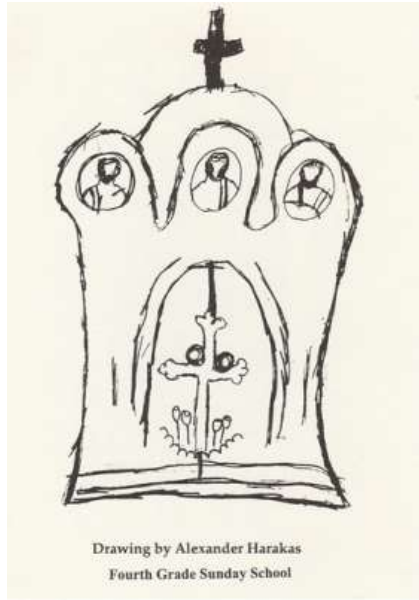

*The Liturgy begins on p 19 of the hymnal. The following are the changeable parts and special instructions.*

*p 29, 2nd Antiphon: Save us, O Son of God, Who were crucified in the flesh....*

*p 37, 3rd Antiphon: Cross Elevation Apolytikion, p 181*

*Hymns after the Gospel Entrance*

Resurrection Apolytikion 4, p 111

Cross Elevation Apolytikion, p 181

Parish Apolytikion, inside hymnal cover

Cross Elevation Kontakion, p 233

*p 77, The Lord's Prayer – English first, Greek last*

*Communion:* Orthodox Christians who have prepared themselves should come forward to receive the Eucharist. Others are invited to join us in partaking reverently of the blessed bread distributed at the close of the service, called “Antidoron” (in place of the Gifts).
